Basic Outfit - Required for each in-school student. To be worn on the first educational day of the month.	<u>POLO</u> - Evergreen <i>Lands' End School Catalog</i> short or long-sleeve; with CCS logo.	<u>DRESS PANTS</u> - Khaki <i>Lands' End School Catalog</i> style	<u>CASUAL SHOES</u> in brown, black, gray, or navy are required. [NOT PERMITTED are Athletic/Tennis or open-toe shoes.] <u>CREW SOCKS</u> - solid CCS colors.	<u>BELTS</u> - black, brown, navy, or khaki and no more than 2" wide w/a traditional size buckle. Must be worn through belt loops.
General Dress Code Guidelines (K-12) <i>Lands' End School Catalog</i> is the guideline for tops, skirts, and pants	<u>POLOS, TURTLENECKS, SWEATERS</u> - (cardigan, crew, v-neck or vests), <u>OXFORD-STYLE SHIRTS</u> (short or long-sleeves). <u>SWEATSHIRTS</u> - <i>Lands' End</i> with CCS logo. (Senior class only - has the option to wear senior hoodies).	<u>PANTS</u> - <i>Lands' End School Catalogue</i> style. (Colors are listed below). NOT PERMITTED are cargo pants, jeans, & corduroy fabric . <u>SKIRTS</u> (K-12) <u>SKORTS/JUMPERS</u> (K-6 only) Khaki or Navy; corduroy fabric is permissible.	<u>KNEE SOCKS</u> - any color/print. <u>TIGHTS/PANTYHOSE</u> - solid CCS colors or skintone. *Girls in Grades 7-12 may wear skirts without hosiery. <u>LEGGINGS</u> - white, navy, grey, black, tan.	<u>BELTS</u> - see above description. <u>TIES</u> - dark, conservative, should be fully tied and worn with a closed collar. *Sweatbands, bandanas, scarves, coats, gloves, hats, blankets, or other non-CCS clothing during school hours are not permitted.
Gym Class Guidelines	<u>TEES</u> - solid color. Tees with athletic logos, CCS logos, or Workathon logos are also permitted.	<u>GYM SHORTS</u> or <u>SWEATPANTS</u> - Shorts must be no more than 4" above the knee. Athletic & CCS logos are permitted.	Tennis shoes for gym class.	
Hot Weather (May 1 - Sept. 30)	Same as "general" policy for tops. ** K - 6th Elementary students may wear solid (CCS colors) or CCS logo tees.	<u>WALKING SHORTS</u> - <i>Lands' End</i> style in khaki, navy, or black. <u>CAPRIS</u> - conservative style in khaki, navy, or black (K-12 girls)	From May 1 - September 30 students may wear <u>TENNIS SHOES</u> and <u>CLOSED-TOE SANDALS</u> with shorts only.	
Athletic/Spirit Attire	To be worn for the specific use of athletes during sporting events and out of school activities. Exceptions may be approved for specific events (i.e. Spirit Day, major game day, etc.)			

Color Guidelines (The *Lands' End School Catalog* is the guideline for colors as well as styles)

TOPS - Burgundy, Navy, Evergreen, White, Light Blue, Yellow. OXFORD SHIRTS - White, light blue, or yellow.

BOTTOMS - Khaki, Navy, (black is now an option for 7th - 12th grade students). ** Girls in 7th - 12th grade may wear skirts in *Lands' End hunter/classic navy plaid*.

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Additional Guidelines

All **shirts** must fit and be worn tucked in. Manufacturer's logos are not permitted unless noted above. Short-sleeved shirts may not be worn with long sleeves underneath. Undershirts may be solid white, gray, black, or navy and if worn are to be beneath polos and oxfords. A collared shirt or turtleneck must be worn under sweaters and CCS sweatshirts at all times.

Pants should have a zipper of a minimum of 4 inches. They are to be hemmed to an appropriate length over shoes and may not be rolled or worn in a manner as to detract from their original design. Pants are to be modest, not too tight or revealing. The following are NOT permitted: cargo pants, jeans (or jean-like fabrics), corduroy fabric, rivets, sewn on patches or patch pockets, rips or tears and shredded hems. Undergarments must not be visible.

Skirts, skorts, jumpers and shorts must be no higher than 3" above the knee.

Dress down days and after school on-campus clothing

Pants: Casual pants, including jeans, are permissible. No sagging or tight fitting pants. Zipper length must be a minimum of 4". Pants are to be hemmed to an appropriate length over shoes. No rips, tears, or holes. No shredded hems. Undergarments must not be visible.

Shirts: Casual shirts, including tees and sweatshirts. NO muscle shirts, tank tops, low-cut necklines, bare midriff or body-hugging apparel and absolutely no offensive pictures or messages.

Skirts: Casual skirts, including jeans. Girls in grades K-12 must wear skirts no higher than 3" above the knee.

Shorts (May 1st - September 30th : Casual, athletic or jean shorts in any color or print. Must be no higher than 3" above the knee. No Spandex/biker shorts permitted on campus.

Shoes: Casual shoes.

Hats: Not permitted during school hours.
