



School Cancellation Procedure



Christian Community School may cancel or delay the start of the school day for one of four reasons:

1. Inclement weather, making travel hazardous.
2. Facility problem or dysfunction limiting school operation
3. National, state, or community emergency
4. Significant impact of staff and/or student illness on school operation

Considerations in cancelling school due to **weather**

The principal assesses the situation via local forecasts and consults with various staff and families on local conditions. Our families come from a wide radius, from Bay Village to Medina, and different weather systems can occur simultaneously.

We do not automatically call school off because other schools do, but area closings are considered. Please be aware that local public schools factor in bussing when determining closings and delays, whereas CCS is primarily concerned with road conditions.

No later than 6:45am, a decision is made and communicated. CCS families are informed of school closings in the following ways:

1. **Parentsquare** post announcing cancelled classes and activities
2. **Local news** website, radio, television announcements: WCRF 103.3 FM and Channels 3, 5, and 8
