


2021-2022 CCS Upper School Dress Code

7th - 12th Grades

PURPOSE FOR HAVING A DRESS CODE

1. To promote school identity through a coordinated style of clothing.
2. To present a neat appearance and avoid any immodesty as befitting a Christian school student.
3. To eliminate worldly competition and socio-economic distinctions as expressed through clothing.
4. To eliminate drawing attention to one's outer self through extremes in style facilitating focus in the learning environment.

Our Lands' End School Uniform code is #9000-3512-2. Please note that the Lands' End School Uniform Catalog is the defining guide as to the approved style of CCS uniform clothing. When in doubt—please ask the Main Office directly.

	SENIOR CLASS HOODIES: This is a privilege reserved for the <u>senior class</u> ONLY. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CCS "Warrior Spirit" hoodies, tees, and polos may be worn by <u>all grades</u> on designated 'Warrior Spirit' days. 		HOT WEATHER (Aug.-Sept., and May-June) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CCS solid color t-shirts and polos, with or without CCS logo, may be worn during hot weather months • Shorts - see "Shorts" box above • Closed toe sandals may be worn during hot weather months only

CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY SCHOOL—DRESS CODE POLICY

Students must follow the guidelines listed in the Dress Code Policy. Violations may result in a warning and/or obtaining appropriate clothing from the Clothing Closet.

Student appearance should remain neat, academically appropriate and modest. Hair length for males must be above the jawline and neat. Dyed or highlighted hair must be of a natural hair color.

Final determinations on dress code/appearance questions are determined by the Principal.

ADDITIONAL GENERAL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES:

SHIRTS: Fit must be modest and appropriate for Christian boys and girls. **Shirts are to be worn tucked in.** The only logo permitted on classroom clothing is the CCS logo. (See the gym class and dress-down guidelines for the exceptions.) Long-sleeve shirts are not to be worn underneath short-sleeve shirts.

PANTS: NO low-rise pants. Pants are to be hemmed to an appropriate length over shoes and may not be worn rolled or in a manner as to detract from their original design. Pants are to be modest, not tight or revealing.

Undergarments must not be visible. The following are **NOT PERMITTED: CARGO PANTS, DENIMS, CORDUROYS, RIVETS, SEWN-ON PATCHES, or PATCH POCKETS. NO RIPS, TEARS, or SHREDDED HEMS.**

SKIRTS, SKORTS, JUMPERS: No shorter than 3" above the knee.

SHORTS: No shorter than 3" above the knee.

DRESS-DOWN DAYS and AFTER-SCHOOL ON CAMPUS CLOTHING

DRESS-DOWN PANTS: Jeans are ok. Even though it is a dress-down day the following are not permitted...

- NO sagging or tight fitting pants.
- No low-rise pants.
- No rips, tears, or holes.
- No shredded hems.
- Undergarments must not be visible.

DRESS-DOWN SHIRTS: Tees and sweatshirts are OK. We still expect that you to look neat and appropriately dressed, as befitting modest young men and women.

- **NO muscle shirts, tank tops, low-cut necklines, bare midriffs, or body hugging apparel**
- **NO offensive pictures or messages.**

DRESS-DOWN SKIRTS: Jeans skirts are ok.

- 3 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE rule applies here.

DRESS-DOWN SHORTS: (May 1st—September 30th) Jean shorts or hot weather style shorts or capris in any color.

- **Must be no shorter than mid-thigh.**
- **NO Spandex, biker shorts or yoga pants are permitted on campus.**
