Purpose:

The K-12 Physical Education Teacher & 6-12 Athletic Director provides Christ-centered leadership in physical education and athletics. This role shapes students physically, socially, and spiritually by promoting healthy lifestyles, teamwork, discipline, and godly character—both in the classroom and through competitive sports programs.

Elementary School Emphasis (K-5)

Primary Focus: Foundations, Joy of Movement, and Character Formation

Key Responsibilities

- Teach fundamental motor skills, coordination, and age-appropriate fitness activities.
- Foster a love for physical activity through fun, engaging, and inclusive lessons.
- Emphasize sportsmanship, respect, cooperation, and perseverance.
- Integrate biblical principles such as kindness, self-control, and teamwork into daily instruction.
- Create a safe, nurturing environment that builds confidence and positive self-image.
- Communicate regularly with classroom teachers and parents regarding student growth.

Middle School Emphasis (6–8)

Primary Focus: Skill Development, Team Identity, and Leadership Growth

Key Responsibilities

- Develop students' athletic skills, fitness habits, and understanding of organized sports.
- Encourage responsibility, discipline, and respect for authority and peers.
- Introduce students to school athletic opportunities and expectations.
- Support early leadership development and accountability among student-athletes.
- Serve as a bridge between elementary foundations and upper school competition standards.

Upper School Emphasis (9–12)

Primary Focus: Excellence, Mentorship, and Christ-Centered Competition

Key Responsibilities

- Promote lifelong fitness and personal responsibility for health and wellness.
- Mentor student-athletes in leadership, integrity, and perseverance.
- Prepare students for competitive athletics while maintaining a Christ-honoring approach to sportsmanship.
- Model professionalism, resilience, and servant leadership on and off the field.

Athletic Director Responsibilities (Grades 6–12)

Program Leadership

- Provide vision and oversight for all middle and upper school athletics in alignment with the school's Christian mission.
- Cultivate a culture of excellence, unity, respect, and Christ-like character.

Scheduling & Operations

- Develop and manage seasonal schedules for all teams.
- Coordinate games with other schools and athletic associations.
- Schedule referees/officials for all home competitions.
- Oversee facilities use, transportation coordination, and game-day logistics.

Staffing & Supervision

- Recruit, recommend, and onboard coaches for each team.
- Provide supervision, evaluation, and professional guidance for coaching staff.
- Ensure coaches model Christian character and uphold school standards.

Student-Athlete Development

- Establish expectations for conduct, eligibility, and sportsmanship.
- Support the spiritual and personal growth of student-athletes.
- Promote safety, proper training, and care of equipment and facilities.

Qualifications

Required

- Bachelor's degree in Physical Education, Education, or related field.
- Personal commitment to Jesus Christ and agreement with the school's statement of faith.
- Experience teaching physical education and/or coaching at the school or youth level.
- Strong organizational, communication, and leadership abilities.

Preferred

- Teaching certification.
- Prior experience as an Athletic Director or athletic program coordinator.

- CPR/First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain).

Professional Expectations

- Serve as a Christ-centered role model for students, families, and colleagues.
- Demonstrate integrity, humility, and professionalism in all settings.
- Support and actively promote the mission, vision, and values of the school.
- Maintain a positive and encouraging presence at school and athletic events.

Work Schedule

- Full-time position including part of school-day teaching responsibilities and athletic duties that may involve evenings and weekends during sports seasons.
